## **RESEARCH OUTCOME**

In 2002, the researchers in the Dept. of Psychology produced 136 publications - 115 type-1 and 21 type-2. In 2001 these figures were 86 and 30. In terms of publication types, there are 20 book chapters and 1 book, 106 journal articles and 9 other texts. This is based on the contributions of those who participated in the publications data collection, i.e., 42 out of 47 staff members.
